Sunnyside School District has been approved to operate the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) beginning in school year 2019-20 for a period of four years and expiring June 30, 2023. The participating schools and claiming percentages are as follows:

Sunnyside School District	
Identified Students:	4311
Enrollment:	6743
Identified Student Percentage:	63.93%
Free Claiming Percentage:	100%
Paid Claiming Percentage:	0%

During this time, the district/participating sites must offer breakfast and lunch at no cost to all students in participating schools. Claims for reimbursement must be filed in the Washington Integrated Nutrition System (WINS) to show the total number of breakfasts and lunches served at each site. WINS will apply the approved claiming percentages to claims for reimbursement each month for sites participating in CEP.

As of April 1 of each school year, the district will have the opportunity to determine the identified student percentage (ISP) for the district/participating schools and apply to increase claiming percentages as applicable. Should the identified student percentage decrease, the district/participating schools are not required to adjust the free and paid claiming percentages during the four-year period.
